

MERRICK'S 50/50 RAFFLE RULES

- 1. Parties. The 50/50 Raffle (hereinafter "Raffle") shall be conducted by Merrick, Inc., (hereinafter "Licensee") pursuant to a license (hereinafter "License") issued by the Minnesota Gambling Control Board (hereinafter "GCB") and in accordance with the regulatory Statutes of Minnesota, and the terms of the Raffle Agreement between Licensee, B&B Marketing LLC (hereinafter "Service Provider") and Ascend Canada, Ltd (hereinafter "Equipment Provider").
- **2. Date and Location of Draw.** The draw will take place by "Manual Drum Draw" (MDD) at 3210 Labore Road, St. Paul, MN 55110 each Monday at 1:00 p.m., CST.
- **3. Rules.** These are the official Raffle Rules and are available upon written or email request to John Wayne Barker, 3210 Labore Road, St. Paul, MN 55110 or jwb@merrickinc.org.
- 4. Eligibility. The Raffle is open to all persons who are located in the State of Minnesota at participating locations of the Licensee authorized to operate Raffles. Ticket purchasers must be 18 years of age or older. Employees of the Service Provider, the Distributor, the Licensee including its Board of Trustees and employees, volunteers, and members of their immediate family (defined as mother, father, brother, sister, son, daughter, husband or wife, who reside in the same household) are NOT eligible to participate (defined as purchase tickets or receive prizes) in the Raffle. Each ticket sold shall be eligible to participate in each MDD conducted under the authority of the License (eligibility will meet GBC Rules).
- 5. Minor Children. Purchasers are not to give their ticket to any person under the age of eighteen (18) years.
- **6.** Tickets. Ticket pricing shall be:
 - (a) Regular: Five dollars (\$5.00) for three (3) tickets;
 - (b) Discount 1: Ten dollars (\$10.00) for ten (10) tickets; or
 - (c) Discount 2: Twenty (\$20.00) for thirty (30) tickets.
- **7. No Refunds.** All ticket sales are final. There will be no refunds issued to anyone for any reason. All tickets purchased and entered into the MDD cannot be refunded, including if ticket Purchaser made an error in selecting the amount of tickets they desire to purchase.
- **8. How to purchase.** Tickets will be sold by Licensee at its sites authorized by the GCB. An eligible person (hereinafter "Customer") will purchase Raffle tickets from the Licensee's employee. The Licensee's employee will print the tickets and exchange them for the correct payment from the Customer. The Customer is solely responsible for retaining their copy of the ticket and keeping it in legible condition for the purpose of winner verification.
- 9. The MDD. Tickets will be available for purchase starting at 9 a.m., CST on Tuesday of each week. Sales will close at 11 p.m., CST the following Sunday of each week. The MDD shall take place after sales close, as soon as possible on the Monday after the selling week. The winning ticket will be selected via MDD of all tickets purchased from that selling week. A Declaration and Release (hereinafter "Release") must be executed by the winner no later than five (5) business days after his/her receipt of the Release. The winner's name will be publicized on the list of prize winners located at Licensee locations. All prizes will be awarded to the winners via check within thirty (30) calendar days of the winner delivering the winning Raffle Ticket, executed Release, and all other required documents.

10. The Prize. In each Raffle the prize will be fifty (50%) of the gross revenue from all Raffle tickets sold from Tuesday through Sunday (hereinafter "Jackpot"). Prizes are not transferable and must be accepted as awarded with no substitutions, except at the Licensee's sole discretion. The prize shall be paid by check from the Licensee. The designated Raffle ticket is validation for claiming the prize.

Unauthorized persons copying, selling or altering tickets are subject to prosecution. A ticket will be void and a prize not paid/redeemed if there is proof that the ticket was stolen, not issued, ineligible, altered, counterfeit, defective, printed in duplicate, or printed/produced in error. The Service Provider and the Licensee are not responsible for lost or stolen tickets or tickets redeemed in error by their agents. All tickets, transactions, and winners associated with the Raffle are subject to the rules, regulations, and procedures put in place by the Licensee and the GCB.

11. Winner Notification. The jackpot amount and winning ticket number will be posted on Licensee's website by 5 p.m., CST each Monday after a Raffle has been played. In the case of a discrepancy between the posted number and the actual number selected, the official number selected and recorded by Licensee will be considered to be the valid winning number. The holder of the winning ticket has thirty (30) calendar days from the announcement of the winning ticket number to present the winning ticket to the Licensee. The holder of the winning ticket may claim their prize by contacting the Licensee's representative Wendy Busch at 3210 Labore Road, St. Paul, MN 55110 or wbusch@merrickinc.org. To claim the prize, the Customer must present their winning ticket, complete the Release form, and present a copy of their government issued photo identification.

All Prizes not claimed on or before the Prize Expiration Date (5:00 p.m., CST thirty (30) calendar days from the time of the announcement of the winning ticket number), will be added to one or more Jackpots at the discretion of the Licensee with GCB approval. This means that any unclaimed Prizes will be added to the Jackpot of another Raffle conducted by the Licensee.

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- 13. Cancellation. The Licensee may rescind, cancel, amend or revoke any Raffle, subject to the prior approval of the GCB. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the Licensee reserves the right to cancel or modify the Raffle and/or these Official Rules, in whole or in part and without notice, if the Licensee determines that fraud or technical or other failures have threatened or destroyed the integrity of the Raffle.

- **15. RECORDS**. All completed tickets, forms, and reports are held by the Licensee who will file and retain them for three (3) years.
